



After fire, Art Corner reopens in new spot

The Art Corner, a 30-year veteran business in Salem, reopened Monday. The shop on Mill Hill was destroyed by fire on the night of April 24. June 2 was considered a "soft" opening, as half the equipment, supplies and phone lines are not in place yet.

The Art Corner will hold a grand reopening on Saturday, June 14, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., at a *new* location at 231 Washington St.

The event will commemorate the shop's return to business and to service to it's longtime and new customers and friends. Events include Painting Demonstrations by well-known local artist Charles Lang, world-renowned science fiction and Godzilla artist Bob Eggleton and award winning fantasy and children's book artist, Marianne Plumridge.

Coffee, tea, cheese and chocolates will be served, as well as other goodies. A special exhibit showing the effects of the fire will be highlighted.
